Cause of Death	
Blunt force trauma	The Office of the Medical Investigator determined death was caused by blunt force trauma.
Gunshot wounds	The Office of the Medical Investigator determined death was caused by gunshot wounds.
Other cause of death	The Office of the Medical Investigator determined death was caused by some other mechanism of injury. For example, asphyxiation, suffocation, poisoning, etc.
Stab wounds	The Office of the Medical Investigator determined death was caused by stab wounds.

Sexual Assault

At Least One Party Was Using Alcohol	
Alcohol involved	Incident involved at least one party who was using alcohol at the time of the death.
At Least One Party Was Using Illegal Drugs	
Illegal drugs involved	Incident involved at least one party who was using illegal drugs at the time of death.

Presence of a Minor	
Minor present at homicide incident	There was at least one-person age 17 years or younger present at the location at the time of the homicide incident.

Conviction	
First degree murder conviction	The homicide offender was convicted of first-
Consul do man a mundon constituion	degree murder for the homicide.
Second degree murder conviction	The homicide offender was convicted of second- degree murder for the homicide.
Voluntary manslaughter conviction	The homicide offender was convicted of voluntary manslaughter for the homicide.
Involuntary manslaughter conviction	The homicide offender was convicted of involuntary manslaughter for the homicide.
Charged but not convicted	The homicide offender was charged with at least one crime, but not convicted for the homicide or any other charge.
Non-murder charge	The homicide offender was convicted of a charge other than murder for the homicide.

IPV perpetrator	Homicide offender was IPV perpetrator in the incident leading to the death.
Neither perpetrator nor victim	Homicide offender was not party to the IPV incident leading to the death.

Relationship	Relationship characteristics refer to the
	relationship between the victim and perpetrator

Relationship Status Between the IPV Victim and Perpetrator	
Dating	The IPV victim and perpetrator were dating at the time of the homicide incident, never married.
Previously dated	The IPV victim and perpetrator had been dating but had ended the relationship before the homicide incident.
Married	The IPV victim and perpetrator were married at the time of the homicide incident.
Divorced	The IPV victim and perpetrator were divorced at the time of the homicide incident.
Other or unknown relationship	The relationship between the perpetrator and the victim of the IPV was other or unknown in the time leading up to the homicide incident.

Living together	The IPV victim and perpetrator shared a
	residence at the time of the homicide incident.

History of Violence in the Intimate Partner Relationship	
Physical violence	There was a history of physical violence in the relationship.
Verbal abuse	There was a history of verbal abuse in the relationship.
Other type of abuse	There was a history of other types of abuse in the relationship E.g. stalking, pet abuse, child abuse, etc.
No history of abuse	There was no known history of intimate partner violence in the relationship.

History of police calls	The IPV victim and perpetrator had a history of
	calls to the police for IPV.
History of arrests	The IPV victim and perpetrator had a history that
	included at least one arrest of either party for a
	household member crime.
History of domestic violence order of protection	The IPV victim and perpetrator had a history that
	included at least one petition for a domestic
	violence order of protection.

Shared Children	
Shared children	The IPV victim and perpetrator shared biological
	or adopted children who were under the age of
	17 at the time of the homicide incident.

IPV Victim	
IPV Victim	The intimate partner violence victim is the
	member of the intimate partner pair against
	whom violence is committed by a current or
	former intimate partner. The IPV victim may be a
	homicide offender or decedent.

Victim Sex	
Female	The victim of the intimate partner violence was
	female.
Male	The victim of the intimate partner violence was
	male.

Victim Age	
10 to 24	The victim of the intimate partner violence was between the ages of 10 and 24.
25 to 59	The victim of the intimate partner violence was between the ages of 25 and 59.
60+	The victim of the intimate partner violence was 60 years of age or older.

Victim had IPV Perpetration History	
History of IPV Perpetration	Has a known history of perpetrating intimate partner violence.
No History of IPV Perpetration	Has no known history of perpetrating intimate partner violence.

No History of IPV Victimization	Has no known history of intimate partner violence victimization.

IPV Perpetrator	
IPV Perpetrator	The intimate partner violence perpetrator is the
	member of the intimate partner pair that
	engages in violence against their current or
	former intimate partner. The IPV perpetrator
	may be a homicide offender, a decedent, or both.

Perpetrator Sex	
Perpetrator was female	The perpetrator of the intimate partner violence was female.
Perpetrator was male	The perpetrator of the intimate partner violence was male.

Perpetrator Age	
Perpetrator age 10 to 24	The perpetrator of the intimate partner violence was between the ages of 10 and 24.
Perpetrator age 25 to 59	The perpetrator of the intimate partner violence was between the ages of 25 and 59.
Perpetrator age 60+	The perpetrator of the intimate partner violence was 60 years of age or older.
